Important things to consider when choosing subjects:

- Make yourself familiar with the 2026 Curriculum Handbook which is available to download from the school website under '2026 Curriculum Handbooks'.
- Visit the GHS Careers Website www.geelonghscareers.com and complete interests quizzes, your resume, explore pathway options from a GAP year, Universities, Apprenticeships and TAFE
- Keep your options open (your ideas could change in the next year or two)
- Consider doing a range of subjects (Arts, English, HAPE, Humanities, Languages, Maths, Science, Technologies)
- Consider a VET subject outside of the school, School Based Apprenticeships or VM
- Select subjects which interest you and you succeed at
- Avoid doing more than two folio subjects
- Try to avoid doing a very narrow selection that limits your options and choose a level of challenge that gives you the best chance possible at a very strong ATAR. Discuss with your teacher if in doubt.
- Select subjects which are important for your preferred career path
- You can do multiple Maths and English classes; add them as subject choices
- Consider accelerating into doing a VCE Unit 3 and 4 subject when you're in Year 11, especially if you've already done a VCE subject in 2025 (you must follow all advanced subject requirements)
