

## Introduction

We are proud of our school, and we show this by the manner in which we present ourselves in uniform. Our school has a uniform which we expect students to wear correctly every day.

- Sports uniform may be worn on days when students have practical sport, dance or physical education classes.
- If a student is out of uniform at any time, they are required to bring a note from their parent/carer, detailing the reasons for being out of uniform, and obtain an out of uniform pass from their House Office at the start of the day.
- There are no specified times when summer or winter uniform is to be worn, but in general winter uniform is worn in Terms Two and Three.

The uniform is only available from PSW (164 Malop Street, Geelong), and A-Plus Uniforms (Shop 5, Belmont Walk, 33 Thomson St, Belmont).

#### Please note:

Next year GHS will be transitioning from a woollen v-neck jumper to a rugby jumper. The v-neck will be able to be worn in future years and is currently available in to purchase. The rugby jumper is not yet available but will be early in 2023.

### **GENERAL COMBINATIONS**

- Grey trousers (traditional male cut) or Geelong High School navy shorts (traditional male cut)
- Pale blue, short- or long-sleeved shirt, worn open-necked or with a school tie (optional).
- Official Geelong High School jumper or soft shell jacket
- White socks
- Black T-Bars or plain, polishable, black leather lace-up school shoes with no visible brands are to be worn
- Casual trainers, sports shoes and boots (eg, Doc Martins) are not acceptable

### OR

## Summer specific uniform

- Check dress in school colours <u>or</u> navy tailored shorts (traditional female cut) with a white shirt and white socks
- Official Geelong High School jumper or soft shell jacket
- Black T-Bars or plain, polishable, black leather lace-up school shoes with no visible brands are to be worn
- Casual trainers, sports shoes and boots (eg, Doc Martins) are not acceptable

### Winter specific Uniform

- Navy slacks (traditional female cut) with white socks or Gunn tartan winter skirts can be worn with navy tights
- White, short- or long-sleeved shirt
- Official Geelong High School jumper or soft shell jacket
- Black T-Bars or plain, polishable, black leather lace-up school shoes with no visible brands are to be worn
- Casual trainers, sports shoes and boots (eg, Doc Martins) are not acceptable.

### **GENERAL UNIFORM**

- Shirts must be tucked in neatly at the waist at all times when the shirt is not the outer garment
- Plain white T-shirt as an undergarment (optional) which must not be visible except at the neck (not long sleeved)
- Geelong High School twill blazer (optional)
- Navy GHS soft shell jacket may be worn with the school uniform as an outer garment with day to day uniform or sports uniform.

# PHYSICAL EDUCATION AND SPORT UNIFORM

- A navy micro-mesh polo with school logo and house colour stripe
- Navy GHS micro mesh sports shorts available in both a unisex and female cut
- School tracksuit pants available in both unisex and female cut
- When representing the school in interschool sports, students must wear their sports uniform
- Appropriate sports shoes with non-marking soles and white socks

### **GENERAL REQUIREMENTS**

### **HAIR**

- Hair must be tidy, of a natural colour, clean and worn in such a manner that will not interfere with school activities.
- All students must be neatly groomed.
- Hair accessories should be aligned with school colours.

## **HATS & SUNGLASSES**

- Hats and sunglasses are not to be worn inside the school buildings
- Geelong High School logo baseball caps. Caps with any other logo are not acceptable.
- Geelong High School Beanie only. Other beanies are not acceptable.

#### JEWELLERY/MAKEUP

- All jewellery worn must be gold/silver, unobtrusive and discreet.
- Students may only wear a maximum of two small sleepers/studs per ear, one necklace, one watch, one ring and/or one bangle. One nose piercing with a small clear plastic stud is permitted. Other facial piercings are not permitted. Facial piercings and associated jewellery are not permitted. No other jewellery is permitted.
- Staff may require the removal of jewellery for safety purposes.
- A minimal amount of makeup is acceptable.

# **OUT OF UNIFORM**

It will only be on exceptional occasions that students will be out of uniform. When out of uniform, students must report to the House Office on arrival at school with a note from their parent/carer, explaining the reason for being out of uniform. The House Office will then issue a Uniform Pass if the explanation is reasonable. Students arriving at class without a Uniform Pass will be issued with an after school detention.

Sports uniform must be worn when representing the school in interschool competitions.
